### TELL CONGRESS TO:

- ★ Ask the State Department not to certify aid to Colombia until the massacre in San José de Apartadó is fully investigated and the guilty brought to justice.
- ★ Implement the recommendations in *Blueprint for a New Colombia Policy* including strengthening human rights and the rule of law to build peace.
